

# **Marine Creatures Sighted, Stranded or Landed 2010**

- 1/1/10 6 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen heading southeast into the bay from the St. Ives NCI Lookout SW521411 at 1020 hrs
- 1/1/10 12 or more Bottlenose Dolphins, in 3 groups, were very active, playing and breaching, east of the NCI Lookout at St. Ives SW521411 at 1040 hrs
- 1/1/10 4 or more Bottlenose Dolphin were NE of the St. Ives NCI Lookout SW521411 at 1450 hrs
- 1/1/10 6 or more Bottlenose Dolphins, in 2 groups, were north of St. Ives NCI Lookout SW521411 at 1540 hrs
- 2/1/10 6 or more Bottlenose Dolphins, including one juvenile, were playing and circling heading west, 50 metres NE of the St. Ives NCI Lookout SW521411 at 1020 hrs. Gannets were diving in the area. They were later seen playing in an area ½ mile ESE of the Lookout at 1040 hrs
- 2/1/10 A dolphin breached 50 metres north of the NCI Lookout St. Ives SW521411 at 1042 hrs
- 2/1/10 6 or more Bottlenose Dolphins, were breaching and heading west, 70 metres ESE of the NCI Lookout at St. Ives SW521411 at 1100 hrs and later were seen heading west at speed northeast of the Lookout at 1105 hrs
- 2/1/10 2 dolphins were 400 metres NNE of the St. Ives NCI Lookout SW521411 at 1236 hrs
- 2/1/10 4 or 5 Harbour Porpoises were seen 4 Km SSE of Gwennap Head NCI Lookout SW365217 at 1130 hrs
- 8/1/10 2 Fin Whales were seen just west of The Runnelstone SW369200 at 1245 hrs. 4 large blows were seen from both individuals. There were no associated seabirds
- 10/1/10 8 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen heading ESE 400yds north of the NCI Lookout at St. Ives SW521411 at 1145hrs and 6 were seen circling 1 mile ESE of the lookout at 1200 hr
- 10/1/10 4 or more Harbour Porpoises were seen 2 to 4 Km off the Gwennap Head NCI Lookout SW365217 from 1000 to 1200 hrs
- 11/1/10 6 to 8 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen heading SE 200 metres NW of the NCI Lookout at St. Ives SW521411 at 0821 hrs. They were later seen 100 metres NW of the Lookout heading slowly SE at 0929 hrs. At 0844 hrs they were stationary 500 metres NW of the lookout. At 0859 hrs a second pod of 4 to 6 Bottlenose Dolphins was seen entering the Bay from the NW and at 0915 hrs they were 400 metres NE of the Lookout heading slowly SW.
- 12/1/10 6 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen NNE of the NCI Lookout at St. Ives SW521411 at 1623 hrs they were heading SE
- 13/1/10 7 dolphins were heading east toward Hayle Sands off The NCI Lookout St. Ives SW521411 at 1135 hrs
- 15/1/10 3 Bottlenose Dolphin were breaching heading SE off the NCI Lookout at St.Ives SW521411 at 1015 hrs and were later seen 100 metres NE of the Lookout at 1055 hrs
- 16/1/10 A White-beaked Dolphin was found stranded on a beach at St. Mawes SW855329. It was recovered by the Strandings Network for post-mortem and has been confirmed as bycatch
- 19/1/10 A Harbour Porpoise was seen 800 metre south of Penberth Cove SW404226 at 1230 hrs
- 20/1/10 A Harbour Porpoise was seen beneath Gannets just north of The Brisons SW340311 at 1145 hrs
- 20/1/10 4 dolphins were seen 2 miles SE of the NCI Lookout at St. Ives SW521411 at 0845hrs and were seen again heading east about 1 mile ESE of the lookout at 1522hrs. These were probably the resident pod of Bottlenose.
- 21/1/10 5 dolphins were seen 300yds NE of the NCI Lookout at St. Ives SW521411 at 0825hrs. These were probably the resident pod of Bottlenose. There were about 50 Guillemots on the water.
- 22/1/10 2 Harbour Porpoises were seen 2 Km Northwest of Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1230 hrs and there were several brief views over the next hour as they headed south
- 24/1/10 2 dolphins were seen 100 metres east of the NCI Lookout at St. Ives SW521411 at 0944 hrs
- 24/1/10 The tail of a whale was seen as it dived about 1 mile off Dolor Point SW785181 at 1515 hrs
- 26/1/10 4 dolphins were seen off Sennen Cove SW350263 at 1105 hrs.
- 26/1/10 2 dolphins or Harbour Porpoises were seen 400 metres NE of the NCI Lookout at St. Ives SW521411 at 1058 hrs
- 26/1/10 8 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen in the Bay Off Sennen SW352263 at 1100 hrs
- 26/1/10 A small group of 4 or 5 Harbour Porpoise was seen off The lookout at Gwennap Head SW365217 at 1100 hrs
- 27/1/10 8 dolphins were seen heading NW 400 metres NE of the NCI Lookout at St. Ives SW521411 at 0910 hrs

- 7/2/10 A pod of about 10 Common Dolphins was seen heading north off the NCI Lookout at Cape Cornwall SW350318 at 1017 hrs
- 7/2/10 2 Bottlenose Dolphin were seen by divers on the wreck of The Beaumaris in Sennen Cove SW352263
- 7/2/10 8 or more Bottlenose Dolphins were seen heading east ½ mile north of the NCI Lookout at St Ives SW521411 at 1308 hrs. Gannets and Cormorants were fishing near by.
- 12/2/10 A Harbour Porpoise was seen north of The Runnelstone SW369200 during the morning
- 13/2/10 A Grey Seal was seen bottling 50 metres ENE of The NCI Lookout at St. Ives SW521411 at 1230 hrs. There were hundreds of Gannets and Herring Gulls on the surface ½ mile ENE of the lookout.
- 13/2/10 A dead Barrel Jellyfish, *Rhizostoma octopus*, was found stranded on the tide line at Perranporth SW756544 at 1300 hrs
- 16/2/10 A dead whale was seen floating about 2 Km WNW of Pendeen SW377358 at 1100 hrs.
- 17/2/10 A pod of 8 to 10 dolphins, including possibly 2 juveniles, was seen heading SW ½ mile off Carnelloe Long Rock SW441389 at 1300 hrs
- 17/2/10 3 Harbour Porpoises, 2 adults with a baby, were seen 1 Km SW of Gwennap Head NCI Lookout SW365217 at 1015 hrs
- 21/2/10 A dead Fin Whale stranded at Porthtowan SW690482. Probably the whale seen floating off Pendeen on the 16<sup>th</sup>.
- 22/2/10 2 Harbour Porpoises, an adult with baby, were seen right by the Runnelstone SW369200 from 1500 to 1530 hrs
- 25/2/10 A Harbour Porpoise was seen travelling west off the Gwennap Head NCI Lookout SW365217
- 25/2/10 7 dolphins were seen heading west off St. Agnes Head SW846311 at 1430 hrs. A pod of 5 followed by two more close behind.
- 1/3/10 A pod of dolphins was seen off St Agnes SW721151
- 2/3/10 6 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen heading slowly very close inshore off the NCI Lookout at Cape Cornwall, SW350318 at 1130 hrs.
- 2/3/10 A pod of 7 dolphins was seen heading west off Sennen Cove SW350263
- 2/3/10 15 to 20 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen off Porthcurno SW387222 at 1330 hrs. They were spread over a wide area in groups of 4 or 5
- 3/3/10 A rare mollusc, *Pholas Dactylus*, The Common Piddock, was found in the St. Austell Bay area SX0448
- 3/3/10 A Harbour Porpoise was seen 600 metres southeast of Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 at 1015 hrs
- 3/3/10 A pod of Bottlenose Dolphins was seen off Porthgwarra SW371216 at midday
- 5/3/10 3 dolphins, an adult with 2 juveniles, were seen off St Agnes Head SW697515 at 1145 hrs
- 6/3/10 3 Harbour Porpoises, 2 adults with a baby, were seen close to the Runnelstone SW369222 at 1000 hrs
- 9/3/10 2 Grey Seals were seen off Cape Cornwall SW350318 at 1500 hrs
- 12/3/10 A Harbour Porpoise was seen heading west 250 metres off Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 at 0930 hrs and 2 Harbour Porpoises were feeding 100 metres east of the Runnelstone SW369200 at that time.
- 13/3/10 A pod of 6 to 8 Bottlenose Dolphins was seen heading west fast 600 metres NE of the NCI Lookout at St. Ives SW521411 at 1209 hrs. They were seen again off Clodgy Point SW507413 at 1227 hrs, when one breached
- 13/3/10 A male Grey Seal was spotted near Zone Point 50°9.0N 5°1.49W at 1301 hrs
- 15/3/10 A pod of about 25 Common Dolphins was seen heading south with lots of leaping and splashing some way offshore at Gunwalloe Church Cove SW661204 at 1200 hrs
- 15/3//10 A Harbour Porpoise was seen 500 metres east of the Runnelstone SW369222 at 1315 hrs
- 16/3/10 Thousands of Common Starfish, *Asterias rubens*, were found stranded along more than a mile of the tide line, on the beach at Budleigh Salterton SY06822 south east Devon.
- 28/3/10 A pod of 8 or 9 Bottlenose Dolphins including one juvenile, was playing around a Gig and, later, St Mawes Ferry at 1700 hrs
- 31/3/10 A Grey Seal was seen playing off rocks just east of the NCI Lookout at St. Ives SW521411 at 1225 hrs
- 1/4/10 5 dolphins, including one juvenile, were seen heading WNW northeast of St. Ives NCI Lookout SW521411 at 1545hrs. They were followed by 7 more dolphins
- 2/4/10 8 to 10 dolphins were seen 500 yards SE of St. Ives NCI Lookout SW521411 at 0755 hrs. another pod of 6 to 8 were seen heading SE off the station at 1023 hrs, and 6 more were seen 300 yards off the station at 1625 hrs

- 4/4/10 A solitary Bottlenose Dolphin was seen off Botallack SW361338
- 5/4/10 2 Harbour Porpoises were seen south of Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 during the morning
- 6/4/10 4 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen heading NW 500 yards NE of St. Ives NCI Lookout SW521411 at 1040 hrs Another pod of 8 was seen heading east 200 yards east of the station at 1114 hrs, and 6 more were seen heading east 200 yards of the station at 1517 hrs.
- 8/4/10 A pod of about 35 Common Dolphins was playing around a boat just south of The Manacles Reef SW820205 at 1402 hrs
- 8/4/10 A Harbour Porpoise was seen 200 metres west of The Runnelstone Reef SW369200 at 1200 hrs
- 9/4/10 A pod of about 12 Bottlenose Dolphins, 8 adults with 4 juveniles, was being very active, bow riding and tail slapping a boat and breaching near Black Rock Falmouth SW833317 at 1700 hrs
- 10/4/10 3 adult Bottlenose Dolphins were seen heading south 100 metres offshore at Botallack Head SW361338 at 0645 hrs
- 13/4/10 50 or more dolphins and a Basking Shark were seen off The Minack Cliff Theatre SW387220 at 1244 hr
- 13/4/10 A large pod of Common Dolphins was seen off Gwennap Head during the day. Estimates of numbers varied from 40 to 100
- 15/4/10 An inquisitive Grey Seal came close to a boat east of Gillan, Fal Bay, in position 50°4.59N 5°0.19W at 1010 hrs
- 18/4/10 A solitary Bottlenose Dolphin adult was seen moving back and forth, probably feeding, in Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 at 1100 hrs and move out near the Runnelstone SW369200 by 1700 hrs
- 19/4/10 A Harbour Porpoise was seen 1 Km SSW of The Gwennap Head NCI Lookout SW367215 at 1205 hrs
- 19/4/10 A Large Bottlenose Dolphin was seen feeding just off the rocks in Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 from 1130 to 1300 hrs
- 20/4/10 A rare Box Crab (*Calappa*) was netted at depth, 80 miles west of the Scilly Isles. There are 41 known species in this genus, it is not reported which species this one is , but it is now on display alive at the Blue Reef Aquarium in Newquay.
- 23/4/10 A young Bottlenose Dolphin was watched for over ½ hour from 1230 hrs, seriously feeding close inshore at Gamper Bay SW345255. A large Grey Seal was also in the Bay
- 23/4/10 Two Bottlenose Dolphins were bow riding and playing around a catamaran in Newquay Bay SW810620
- 25/4/10 Two Bottlenose Dolphins were playing around a catamaran just outside Newquay Harbour SW807620
- 26/4/10 7 or 8 Bottlenose Dolphins, including 2 juveniles, were bow riding a catamaran just outside Newquay Harbour SW807620. The adults were dark, almost black, the juveniles paler.
- 27/4/10 Two dolphins were seen off Porthcurno SW387222 during the afternoon
- 30/4/10 A pod of dolphins headed south off the NCI Lookout at Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1444 hrs
- 1/5/10 5 adult Bottlenose Dolphins were seen from FV Capriol off Porthcurno SW387222 at 1000 hrs
- 1/5/10 A Male and Female Grey Seal was seen hauled out on Black Rock Falmouth SW834317 and 15 or more dolphins were playing alongside at boat in the area for about 20 minutes from midday
- 5/5/10 2 dolphins headed south off the NCI Lookout at Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1602 hrs
- 8/5/10 a very large Basking Shark, estimate to be 12 metres long, was seen east of the Isles of Scilly in position SW019413 at 1300 hrs
- 9/5/10 A 4 metre Basking Shark was seen going back and forth from Carn Glouce SW354313 to Priest's Cove SW351316 at noon
- 9/5/10 A Basking Shark was spotted from the St. Mawes Ferry near the Cross Roads Buoy in the Carrick Roads 50°9.7N 5°1.49W at 1301 hrs.
- 9/5/10 A large Basking Shark was seen feeding at the surface about 2 miles SE of St Anthony Head SW846311 at 1400 hrs
- 10/5/10 A Basking Shark was seen in St Austell Bay SX0408 during the evening.
- 10/5/10 A Basking Shark was spotted between Tresco and St. Marys, Isles of Scilly SV9013 at 1300 hrs
- 11/5/10 A 6 metre Basking Shark was seen feeding, heading south, ¼ mile offshore in Kennack Bay SW739166 at 2030 hrs.

11/5/10 2 Grey Seals were watched for 10 minutes off Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1300 hrs

12/5/10 A Harbour Porpoise was seen feeding intensely for 10 minutes 500 metres west of Botallack Head SW361338 at 1500 hrs

12/5/10 4 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen off Trevega Cliff SW478410 at 1400 hrs

12/5/10 2 No 6 metre Basking Sharks were seen off Pendeen Watch SW378358 at 1900 hrs

13/5/10 2 No 6 metre Basking Sharks were seen off Botallack Head SW362338 at 0630 hrs

13/5/10 2 No 6 metre Basking Sharks were seen off Pendeen Watch SW378358 at 1245 hrs

13/5/10 A 6 metre Basking Shark was seen off Aire Point SW358282 at 1400 hrs

13/5/10 4 dolphins followed a fishing vessel for ½ a mile heading north off Droskyn Point SW751543 at 0930 hrs.

13/5/10 2 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen off Porthmeor Beach St. Ives SW516410 at 2100 hrs

13/5/10 5 Grey Seals were hauled out on Black Rock Falmouth SW833317, and two more were seen off St Anthony Head SW846311 during the morning.

14/5/10 A Basking Shark was in St. Ives harbour SW520407 at 1700 hrs

15/5/10 A pod of about 80 Common Dolphins was playing around a dive boat for nearly 2 hours about 12 miles north of Padstow SW919753. The dolphins also buzzed the divers at their decompression stop. Two Harbour Porpoises were also seen about 2 miles north of Padstow

16/5/10 A Basking Shark was seen offshore from Porthgwarra SW371216

16/5/10 A Basking Shark was seen below the Watch from the NCI Lookout at Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1445 hrs

16/5/10 A pod of about 80 Common Dolphins, was seen again about 12 miles north of Padstow SW919754 and 2 Harbour Porpoise were seen 2 miles north of Padstow

17/5/10 A Basking Shark was seen close in under the Minack Cliff Theatre SW387220 in the morning and another was seen off Sennen Cove SW351263 in the afternoon

17/5/10 A pod of 10 Risso's Dolphins, including a calf, was seen breaching about ½ mile west of Pendeen Watch SW378358 at 1115 hrs

17/5/10 A Basking Shark was seen off Gywnver SW362276 at 1100 hrs

17/5/10 3 Basking Sharks were seen off Nanquidno Valley SW357294 at 1200 hrs

17/5/10 10 dolphins were seen heading west off Porthmeor Beach St. Ives SW516410 at 1030 hrs. These may have been the Risso's Dolphins seen off Pendeen ¾ hour later.

17/5/10 2 Basking Sharks were seen off Gywnver SW362276 at 2000 hrs. One was about 8 metres long, the other about 5 metres

17/5/10 A Basking Shark was seen off Land's End SW341253 at 1400 hrs

17/5/10 3 Basking Sharks were seen off Godrevy SW581428 at 1100 hrs

17/5/10 An adult Harbour Porpoise was seen heading steadily south off the Brisons SW340311 at 1630 hrs

17/5/10 A Basking Shark was seen off Porthcurno SW387222

18/5/10 4 Basking Shark were close in off Lands End SW341253 in the morning and one was in Whitesand Bay SW3527 and 4 off Botallack SW361335 in the afternoon.

18/5/10 3 Basking Sharks were seen in Whitesand Bay SW3527, An 8 metre skark and a smaller one were off Gywnver and the other was to the SW toward Sennen

18/5/10 A 4 metre Basking Shark was seen off Cape Cornwall NCI Lookout SW349318 at 1630 hrs

18/5/10 A 2.5 metre Basking Shark was seen off the NCI Lookout at Cape Cornwall SW348318 at 1730 hrs

18/5/10 4 Basking Sharks were seen off Botallack Head SW361338 at 1645 hrs

18/5/10 A Basking Shark was seen off Porthcurno SW387222

20/5/10 6 Basking Sharks were seen moving around north of The Cowloe SW348266 at 1115 hrs

20/5/10 A 4 metre Basking Shark was seen about 12 metres north of The Cowloe SW348266 at 1330 hrs. At the same time two 3 metre sharks were close inshore off Lands End SW341253 and another bigger one was about 200 metres off Lands End.

20/5/10 3 Basking Sharks were seen feeding off Holywell Beach SW7659 from 1000 to 1130 hrs One was 4 metres, another 7 metres and the third 8 metres which had a pink patch on the tip of its nose

20/5/10 A large pod of Common Dolphins of about 100, including a few juveniles, were seen in Newquay Bay SW8162. One of the juveniles had a very damaged tail fluke, almost hanging off, but still bow riding a dive boat at 4 knots.

20/5/10 2 Harbour Porpoises were spotted near the Manacles 50°2.45N 5°0.57W and a female Grey Seal was seen hauled out on Black Rock Falmouth SW833317 in the morning.

20/5/10 9 Basking Sharks passed by Lands End SW341253 between 1200 hrs and 1545 hrs.

20/5/10 A Basking Shark was seen off Porthcurno SW387222

- 21/5/10 A Basking Shark was watched feeding for 45 minutes in a small area at the eastern end of the Bay at Kennack Sands SW741166
- 21/5/10 5 Basking Sharks were seen feeding at levels by divers 2 miles off Holywell Bay SW7659. Shark sizes were approx 8m.7m.7m.6m.and 2m. Vis was good at surface but there was soupy plankton at about 5 metres down. Sea conditions force 1, no wind, 1 metre swell, sunny. One shark breached 3 times and was caught on camera twice.
- 21/5/10 A small Basking Shark was seen feeding at the surface about 1 Km off Maen Dower SW356294 at 2000 hrs.
- 21/5/10 An 8 metre Basking Shark was seen ½ mile west of Lands End SW341253 at 1500 hrs and another was seen close in among the rocks at the Longships Reef SW320253 at 1530 hrs
- 22/5/10 A Basking Shark was seen off Porthcurno SW387222
- 22/5/10 A 4 metre Basking Shark was watched for about 2 hours feeding at the surface off Pendower Beach SW900381 from 1400 hrs
- 22/5/10 2 Bottlenose Dolphins put on a real spectacle just off the Helford River mouth SW7926 during the afternoon
- 22/5/10 10 Basking Sharks were seen about 5 miles west of Newquay SW807620 They were mostly feeding with mouths wide open but three were circling with mouths closed beneath snorkelers who returned to the dive boat in case they were disturbing mating behaviour.. The sharks varied in size from 4 metres to 9 metres. There were many Moon Jellyfish floating on the surface
- 22/5/10 A Basking Shark was seen off Carne Bach SW909801 at 1400 hrs
- 22/5/10 A pod of 20 to 30 Common Dolphins was seen 7 miles north of Padstow SW919754
- 23/5/10 A pod of 40 to 50 Common Dolphins was seen 4 miles north of Padstow SW919754
- 23/5/10 A Basking Shark was seen off Gwynver SW362276 in the afternoon
- 23/5/10 A pod of 40 to 50 Common Dolphins was seen 5 miles west of Newquay SW807620
- 23/5/10 A Basking Shark was seen off Porthcurno SW387222
- 24/5/10 10 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen heading east off Porthmeor Beach SW516410 at 0800 hrs they then turned and headed west.
- 24/5/10 A Basking Shark was seen of Porthmeor Beach SW516410 at 1430 and another was seen off the Cove at 1500 hrs
- 24/5/10 A Basking Shark was seen off Kenidjack Castle SW355326 at 1300 hrs
- 24/5/10 4 Basking Sharks were seen off Gamper Bay SW345255 at 1500 hrs. One very large one had a badly torn dorsal
- 24/5/10 A Basking Shark breached 1½ miles west of Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1400 hrs
- 24/5/10 A Basking Shark breached just north of the Longships Reef SW320253 at 1430 hrs
- 24/5/10 There were at least 10 Basking Sharks between Lands End SW341253 and Gamper Bay SW345255 at 1530 hrs
- 24/5/10 A Basking Shark was seen off Lankidden SW755166 at 1200 hrs
- 24/5/10 2 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen off the mouth of the Helford River SW7926 at 1400 hrs
- 24/5/10 1 Bottlenose Dolphin was seen near The Manacles SW820205 at 1630 hrs
- 24/5/10 A pod of 6 to 8 Bottlenose Dolphins headed southwest across St Ives Bay SW5141 from Godrevy to the Hayle river mouth then turned and headed back at 1145 hrs
- 24/5/10 3 groups of large creatures were seen from the cliff near Rame SX427493 moving below the surface in very clear water, up to a total of about 20. They moved along the shoreline, some coming within 30 ft of shore. They then came together and headed out to sea quite quickly. Were these Bottlenose Dolphins or Pilot Whales?
- 24/5/10 3 Basking Sharks were spotted in Gerrans Bay SX8937 at 1230 hrs. One left the Bay, but two were still there at 1425 hrs
- 24/5/10 At least 12 Basking Sharks were off Lands End SW341253, three of which breached. 7 were circling a diver.
- 24/5/10 A Basking Shark was spotted close inshore in Gerrans Bay SW8937 at 1100 hrs. It was joined by another by 1200 hrs and yet another by 1300 hrs. They continued feeding in the same area.
- 24/5/10 A Basking Shark was spotted ½ mile south of Plymouth Breakwater SX471504
- 24/5/10 3 Cyanea lamarckii Jellyfish were spotted off Porth Kidney Beach SW5438 at 1000 hrs
- 25/5/10 A Basking Shark with a very damaged dorsal fin was seen of Penlee Point SX443487 during the evening. Photos were taken and sent. It also had lots of white scarring over its body
- 25/5/10 2 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen at the Mouth of the Helford River SW7826 at 1715 hrs. They stayed around for about an Hour
- 25/5/10 A Basking Shark was seen off Kenidjack Castle SW355326 at 1440 hrs
- 26/5/10 2 Basking Shark were seen in Priest's Cove SW51316

- 26/5/10 An Ocean Sunfish, a prolific number of Moon Jellyfish, a scattering of the Blue Jellyfish, *Cyanea Lamarckii*, and 6 Buoy Barnacles were seen 4 miles off Holywell Bay SW7659
