

# **Marine Creatures Sighted Stranded or Landed 2011**

## **A list compiled by Raymond Dennis**

- 1/1/11 A Harbour Porpoise was seen moving about with occasional long dives off Tater du SW440230 at 1630 hrs
- 1/1/11 There was a seabird feeding frenzy in Whitesand Bay SW4050 during the morning, mainly of Gannets, probably feeding on sprats.
- 1/1/11 3 adult Harbour Porpoises were seen heading south 1 km west of Cape Cornwall SW349318 from 1300 to 1350 hrs
- 2/1/11 A Harbour Porpoise was seen 1 km west of Carn Glouce SW354313 at 1210 hrs, and 2 female Harbour Porpoises each with a juvenile and another adult were seen moving inshore off Sennen SW350263 at 1230 hrs
- 3/1/11 An adult Harbour Porpoise was seen heading south 1 km off Carn Glouce SW354313 at 1515 hrs
- 3/1/11 5 Harbour Porpoises were just east of The Runnelstone SW369200 at 1036 hrs
- 5/1/11 2 Harbour Porpoises an adult with juvenile, were seen 2 Km west of Carn Glouce SW354313 during the day
- 5/1/11 A Grey Seal was watched rolling up onto the beach in the surf off Marazion Station SW506313 from 1600 to 1620 hrs and 4 Harbour Porpoises were watched feeding 300 to 400 metres offshore at the same time.
- 9/1/11 A pod of about 8 Bottlenose Dolphins, including a juvenile, was seen heading south east off Cudden Point SW548275 at 1400 hrs
- 9/1/11 A pod of 5 Bottlenose Dolphins was seen heading southwest off Pordenack Point SW345241 at 1320 hrs
- 14/1/11 A pod of dolphins was seen off Skilly Beach SW460275 during the day.
- 20/1/11 6 Risso's Dolphins and 5 Harbour Porpoises were seen off Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 during the day
- 20/1/11 5 or 6 Harbour Porpoises were seen 500 mts WSW of The Gwennap Head NCI Lookout SW365217 from 1107 to 1145 hrs
- 21/1/11 3 Harbour Porpoises, 2 adults with a juvenile, were feeding under gannets 100 metres southwest of the Brisons SW340311 at 1234 hrs
- 21/1/11 2 Grey Seal were seen at Priests Cove SW351316 at 1245 hrs
- 22/1/11 A pod of 10 Bottlenose Dolphins was seen close in to the Battery Rocks Penzance SW477297
- 23/1/11 A whale described as about 30ft long with no dorsal fin and a blunt nose, so probably a Sperm Whale, was seen heading slowly southeast 400 metre off Prussia Cove SW556279 during the afternoon.
- 27/1/11 A Harbour Porpoise was feeding under Gannets 100 mts west of The Runnelstone SW36922 at 1340 hrs.
- 28/1/11 2 Harbour Porpoises were feeding beneath Gannets off Sennen SW350263 at 1130 hrs
- 30/1/11 6 Bottlenose Dolphins were at Penhale Sands SW756591, feeding breaching and surfing in 3 pairs with human surfers from 1130 to 1200 hrs with a large flock of seabirds in attendance
- 31/1/11 5 or 6 Common Dolphins, were seen heading east 1½ Km SSE of the Gwennap Head NCI Lookout SW365217 at 1120 hrs and were seen again heading west off Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 at 1202 hrs
- 3/2/11 A Harbour Porpoise became live stranded at Downderry Beach SX315538 and was refloated by members of the public before BDMLR medics arrived, and was seen well offshore later.
- 6/2/11 A pod of Bottlenose Dolphins was seen off Pentire Head Newquay SW780615 during the day
- 8/2/11 A pod of about 6 Bottlenose Dolphins was seen first heading east and then west off Mutton Cove SW 584433 at 1200 hrs
- 9/2/11 5 dolphins were seen very close inshore at Downderry SX315538. BDMLR were alerted but no action was taken.
- 15/2/11 A single Risso's Dolphin was seen negotiating a huge wave in a very rough sea at the Runnelstone SW369200 in the afternoon
- 15/2/11 A pod of Risso's Dolphins was seen 400 metres south of Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 at 1450 hrs
- 16/2/11 At least 5 Harbour Porpoises were seen feeding under Gannets 300 metres NW of Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1504 hrs
- 16/2/11 A Common Dolphin live stranded at Hannafore Beach Looe SX257524, BDMLR attended and attempted a refloat 3 times but it restranded each time. A decision was made to euthanase.

- 17/2/11 4 Harbour Porpoises were seen 600 metres NNW of Trevoise Head SW850765 from 1040 to 1120 hrs
- 17/2/11 2 Harbour Porpoises were seen heading north 1 Km west of Kenidjack Head SW354327 at 1430 hrs. They were seen a little later heading north further offshore
- 18/2/11 2 Harbour Porpoises were 200 metres SW of The Brisons SW340311 at 0916 hrs
- 19/2/11 A Harbour Porpoise as seen 500 metres south of Porthcurno SW387222 late morning
- 19/2/11 A Common Dolphin was seen swimming in circles very close inshore at Portscatho SW877354. during the evening BDMLR attended but unable to locate due to darkness when they arrived.
- 20/2/11 A dead Common Dolphin stranded entangled in netting at Falmouth, possibly the one seen off Portscatho last evening.
- 24/2/11 A pod of 10 Bottlenose Dolphins was seen with some surface activity near Black Rock Falmouth SW833317 at 1100 hrs.
- 25/2/11 A small pod of 4 to 6 Risso's Dolphins was seen west of St. Michael's Mount SW514298 during the day.
- 27/2/11 A Harbour Porpoise was seen 100 metres west of The Runnelstone SW369200 and another was seen 800 metres south of the Gwennap Head NCI Lookout SW367217 from 0930 to 1030 hrs
- 3/3/11 2 Harbour Porpoise were seen 400 metres SSE of Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 at 1040 hrs
- 5/3/11 A pod of 8 Bottlenose Dolphins, including 2 juveniles, was seen heading south off Pendennis Point SW826315 at 1300 hrs.
- 6/3/11 A Harbour Porpoise was seen 800 metres SSW of Gwennap Head SW367215 at 1135 hrs
- 8/3/11 2 Harbour Porpoises were seen several times 500 to 700 metres SE of The Runnelstone SW369200, between 0830 and 1030 hrs.
- 8/3/11 4 Harbour Porpoises, 2 adults with 2 juveniles, were 400 metres south of Logan Rock SW396219 at 1150 hrs
- 9/3/11 12 or more Bottlenose Dolphins, including 2 Juveniles and an infant were breaching and bow and stern wave riding a patrol boat in the Carrick Roads in position 50°9.15N 5°2.32W from 1500 to 1530 hrs. One adult had a piece missing at the top of the trailing edge of its dorsal. The infant was only about 2½ ft long and very pale, almost white
- 9/3/11 A pod of 4 or 5 dolphins was seen heading up river off Castle Point St. Mawes SW841326
- 11/3/11 A Harbour Porpoise was seen 300 metres SE of Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 at 0943 hrs
- 13/3/11 7 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen heading southwest off Gurnards Head SW432388 at 1500 hrs
- 16/3/11 A Lamprey was caught in a seine net off Watergate Beach SW8365
- 17/3/11 2 Harbour Porpoises, an adult with a juvenile, were seen several times between 0945 and 1010 hrs, 400 metres SE of Porthgwarra Cove SW371216
- 17/3/11 A Harbour Porpoise was seen 800 metres north of The Cowloe, Sennen SW371216 mid morning.
- 17/3/11 6 or 7 Common Dolphins came in very close behind the Cowloe, Sennen SW371216 at 1115 hrs, then headed north toward The Brisons. They were watched until 1145 and it was noticed that one had a severed dorsal fin, i.e. just a stump. The other animals occasionally breached, but not this one, so perhaps its mobility was affected, but it seemed to swim OK.
- 19/3/11 Plymouth Marine Laboratory Scientists have detected two large algal blooms; one off Ireland and the other covering an area from Lizard Point SW694115 to Salcombe SX7338
- 20/3/11 A Basking Shark approached divers in 8 metres of water off Roskilly SW472272 at 1730 hrs. This is the first Basking Shark report for this year.
- 20/3/11 2 Harbour Porpoises were 2.5 Km west of Carn Glouce SW354313, and 4 to 6 Harbour Porpoises were 250 metres NW of Cape Cornwall SW349318 from 1200 to 1210 hrs.
- 21/3/11 A Harbour Porpoise was behind The Cowloe, Sennen SW348266 at 1420 hrs
- 22/3/11 2 Harbour Porpoises were seen 400 metres NW of The Gwennap Head NCI Lookout SW365217 heading toward Lands End.
- 22/3/11 A pod of 20 to 30 dolphins were seen heading into Mounts Bay off Lamorna Cove SW452241
- 26/3/11 A pod of about 8 Common Dolphins was seen heading west off Logan Rock SW397219 followed by diving birds at 1730 hrs
- 26/3/11 2 Harbour Porpoises were 1 Km south of Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 at 1540 hrs.
- 27/3/11 2 Basking Sharks were seen off Porthcurno SW387222
- 9/4/11 3 Bottlenose Dolphins, 2 adults with juvenile, were seen heading west 500 to 1000 metres off St Anthony Beach SW846311 at 1130 hrs. There was some breaching but no boat interference although there was a Gig nearby.

- 10/4/11 8 to 10 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen close inshore at Polhawn Cove SX42042. They were well spread out as if hunting with some breaching. They moved off from Clear Point towards Rame Head.
- 10/4/11 A Basking Shark was seen feeding ½ mile off Carn Dhu SW457238 at 1240 hrs
- 10/4/11 A pod of 5 Bottlenose Dolphins was heading southwest off Carn Dhu SW457238 at 1400 hrs
- 13/4/11 A Basking Shark was seen near the north end of The Brisons Reef SW340311 from Carn Goose at 1800 hrs
- 14/4/11 About 30 Common Dolphins were seen off Gwennap Head SW367215 from 1430 to 1620 hrs
- 15/4/11 About 30 Common Dolphins were seen off The Minack Cliff Theatre SW387220 at 0800 hrs
- 15/4/11 A Harbour Porpoise was seen about 800 metres SW of The Gwennap Head NCI Lookout SW365217 at 1548 hrs
- 16/4/11 8 Harbour Porpoises were spread out in the tide race around the Runnelstone SW369222 from 0830 to 1005 hrs. It was flat calm and 3 individuals were seen breaching.
- 19/4/11 3 small Basking Sharks, all less than 12 ft long, were feeding at the surface in 20 metres of water ½ mile off Gribben Head SX098494 in position 50°18.5N 04°40.5W at 1400 hrs
- 25/4/11 A Basking Shark was seen off Logan Rock SW396217
- 26/4/11 A pod of about 16 Common Dolphins was seen off the Gwennap Head NCI Lookout SW365217
- 28/4/11 A Basking Shark was seen off Porthgarra SW371216 early morning
- 4/5/11 A pod of 5, possibly 6, Bottlenose Dolphins were off Nare Head SW800247 at 1400 hrs
- 7/5/11 An adult Harbour Porpoise with a baby, were seen at Sennen Cove SW531263, and the baby stranded. Members of the public put the baby back into the sea but it stranded itself again. BDMLR were called but when they arrived the baby died. The baby had whiskers and parts of the umbilical cord were attached, it was very small and underweight. It was taken to Polwheil for post-mortem. The mother swam parallel to the beach for a while then when out to sea.
- 9/5/11 A Grey Seal was seen off Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 1300 hrs
- 11/5/11 2 dolphins, thought to be Bottlenose Dolphins, were seen breaching ¼ mile off Long Rock SW498308 at 1340 hrs
- 15/5/11 A 4-5 metre Basking Shark was seen feeding just below the surface in rough seas just east of Lizard Point SW694115 at 1330 hrs. It was heading east
- 18/5/11 2 Basking Sharks were seen off Porthcurno SW387222
- 19/5/11 A Basking Shark was feeding close inshore off Porth Ledden SW352320 at 1300hrs
- 25/5/11 A Basking Shark was seen off Porthcurno SW387222
- 27/5/11 4 Bottlenose Dolphins were spotted near Wherry Rocks, Newlyn SW470274 at 1050 hrs then they quickly headed toward Newlyn Harbour Mouth and onwards toward Roskilly
- 27/5/11 5 Bottlenose Dolphins were playing with a Grey Seal close in below the NCI Lookout at Cape Cornwall SW350318 at 1530 hrs
- 27/5/11 A pod of dolphins was seen off Porthcurno SW387222. These were probably the Bottlenose Dolphins passing from Newlyn to Cape Cornwall
- 4/6/11 A Harbour Porpoise was seen heading northwest from the BDMLR Rib "Josh", off Clodgy Point SW507413 at 1015 hrs
- 11/6/11 A 4 metre Basking Shark was spotted at the surface briefly before it dived 1 mile south of St. Michaels' Mount SW514298 at 1340 hrs.
- 14/6/11 A 25ft whale was spotted briefly off Dartmouth SX8851. Not long at the surface, blew once then dived. Thought to be a Minke.
- 19/6/11 A Basking Shark was seen feeding at the surface close in among rocks at Carn Everis, St. Ives Island SW518413 at 1400 hrs. It then headed west.
- 19/6/11 A pod of 7 Bottlenose Dolphins was Seen off St Michael's Mount SW515301 mid morning. They moved across the Bay heading west and were seen early afternoon off Lamorna SW451241. They headed back eastwards and were seen later in the day to the east of The Mount
- 22/6/11 A Grey Seal was seen close in below the NCI Lookout at Cape Cornwall SW350318 at 1230 hrs, and 2 more were seen just north of the headland off Porth Ledden SW352320 at 1530 hrs
- 24/6/11 2 dolphins , probably Bottlenose Dolphins, sped past Porthgarra Cove SW371216, with a grey RIB in hot pursuit, actually driving at them. 4 or 5 aboard were not divers, but dressed in ordinary weatherproof gear.
- 25/6/11 A Basking Shark was seen off Porthcurno Bay SW387222 during the afternoon.
- 27/6/11 2, possibly 3, Harbour Porpoises, were 500 metres SE of Porthgarra Cove SW371216 at 1535 hrs
- 28/6/11 3 Common Dolphins were seen off Polzeath SW93-78- during the day

- 28/6/11 8 or more Basking Sharks went by off the RSPB Hide at Land's End SW341253 during the day.
- 29/6/11 A pod of about 20 Bottlenose Dolphins was playing around close in at Porthgwarra SW371216 at 1645 hrs
- 30/6/11 2 small Bottlenose Dolphins were seen off Logan Rock SW396219 at 1330 hrs
- 30/6/11 A pod of 7 Common Dolphins with calves and 2 Grey Seals were seen from a dive boat 13 miles west of Newquay SW807620, and another large pod of Common Dolphins was seen later in the day.
- 1/7/11 A pod of about 20 Bottlenose Dolphin was playing around a boat a mile offshore between Gyllyngvase SW810316 and Helford Passage SW790265 at 1430 hrs
- 1/7/11 A Minke Whale was seen to surface three times while heading east 3 Km southwest of Gwennap Head SW367215 at 1705 hrs
- 1/7/11 A Harbour Porpoise was seen 2.5 Km west of the Gwennap Head NCI Lookout SW365217 at 1610 hrs
- 2/7/11 A Harbour Porpoise was seen 150 metres north of The Brisons SW340311 at 0914 hrs
- 2/7/11 A pod of 25 or Common Dolphins was seen under gannets about 5 Km west of Carn Glouce SW354313 at 0930 hrs
- 2/7/11 5 Common Dolphins were seen heading south 250 metres offshore at Cape Cornwall SW349318 at 0958 hrs
- 2/7/11 A pod of 12 to 15 Common Dolphins, including several juveniles, was seen heading south outside The Brisons SW340-311 at 1028 hrs.
- 2/7/11 3 family pods of Bottlenose Dolphins were seen off Polzeath SW9378 today
- 2/7/11 An adult Minke Whale was seen about 8 miles off St. Michael's Mount SW514298 during the afternoon.
- 4/7/11 2 Harbour Porpoises were seen 250 metres northwest of Cape Cornwall SW349318 during the morning.
- 6/7/11 2 Whitebeaked Dolphins and 8 Harbour Porpoises were seen from the RSPB hide at Land's End SW341253 between 1000 and 1700 hrs.
- 6/7/11 3 Basking Sharks were seen off Gamper Bay SW345255 at 1500 hrs
- 8/7/11 Two small groups, totalling 10 to 20 Common Dolphins, were feeding under gannets, south and southeast of Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 at 1710 hrs.
- 9/7/11 2 Harbour Porpoises, an adult with a juvenile, were seen 1 Km southwest of the Gwennap Head Lookout SW365217 at 1230 hrs
- 9/7/11 4 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen close inshore at Porthcurno SW387222 and 2 Basking Sharks were seen well offshore.
- 12/7/11 2 Harbour Porpoises were seen feeding off Porthgwarra SW365217.
- 13/7/11 A 30 ft Humpback Whale was seen entangled in rope/net 4 miles off St Ives SW520407. It was last seen heading west during the afternoon.
- 14/7/11 A 3 metre Basking Shark was seen near the Brisons SW340311 at 1130 hrs. It was watched for 15 minutes from the Cape Cornwall NCI Lookout until it disappeared behind the Brisons
- 14/7/11 2 pods of Common Dolphins, of about 20 in each pod were seen breaching at Low Lee, Mounts Bay SW481272 at 1530 hrs. They were still in the same are at 1900 hrs
- 14/7/11 2 Ocean Sunfish were seen near The Runnelstone SW369200 at about 1800 hrs
- 14/7/11 2 Harbour Porpoises were seen off Cape Cornwall SW350318 at about 1730 hrs
- 14/7/11 A 30 ft Humpback Whale was seen off Clodgy Point SW507413 entangled in rope/nets at 1630 hrs observed by several people.
- 14/7/11 A Whale, confirmed as a juvenile Humpback, by BDMLR Medics, was found off Carn Naun , near Zennor, entangled in thick rope, with thinner rope wrapped across its body in front of its dorsal, cutting into the blubber. It appeared to be feeding normally, without impediment along a plankton front. Rescue attempts by the BDMLR team on board RIB "Josh" and MV "Atlantic Diver" almost succeeded, but had to be aborted due to tide and nightfall. The BDMLR Medics were in attendance from 1900 to 2100 hrs.
- 15/7/11 2 Ocean Sunfish were seen off St. Ives SW520407 by BDMLR Medics, who were out looking for the entangled whale.
- 15/7/11 At least 2 Harbour Porpoises and 3 Grey Seals were seen off Gwennap Head SW367215 by the Seawatch team today
- 16/7/11 2 or more Common Dolphins, at least 4 and up to 7 Harbour Porpoises, Grey Seals, and 2 Ocean Sunfish were seen by the Seawatch Team off Gwennap Head SW367215 today
- 17/7/11 6 or more Risso's Dolphins, 3 Harbour Porpoises, and 3 or more Grey Seals were seen off Gwennap Head SW367215 by the Seawatch team today.

- 18/7/11 Up to 6 Harbour Porpoises, 5 Ocean Sunfish and 3 or more Grey Seals were seen by the Seawatch team at Gwennap Head SW367215 today
- 18/7/11 A pod of 15 or more Common Dolphins was seen off Rumps Point SW931812 at midday
- 19/7/11 A Basking Shark was seen off Pendeen Watch SW377358 during the day.
- 19/7/11 3 Harbour Porpoises, 2 adults with a juvenile, were seen 500 metres southeast of Porthgwarra Cove Sw371216 at 1620 hrs
- 19/7/11 4 Bottlenose Dolphins were seen and photographed close in off The Minack Cliff Theatre SW387220 and 2 Basking Sharks could be seen well offshore
- 19/7/11 Up to 6 Harbour Porpoises, 5 Ocean Sunfish and 3 or more Grey Seals were seen off Gwennap Head SW367215 by the Seawatch team today.
- 19/7/11 An Ocean Sunfish was seen offshore at Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 at 1621 hrs
- 20/7/11 Up to 12 Harbour Porpoises, 4 Ocean Sunfish, and 4 Grey Seals were seen off Gwennap Head SW367215 by the Seawatch team today.
- 20/7/11 A small whale was seen to breach 100 metres beyond surfers, (200Metres from beach) at Porthtown SW690482 this morning.
- 21/7/11 2 to 4 Common Dolphins were seen 2.5 Km west of the Gwennap Head Lookout SW356217 at 1150 hrs
- 21/7/11 32 or more Common Dolphins, that arrived in 5 small pods in the evening, up to 8 Harbour Porpoises, 2 Grey Seals and 2 Ocean Sunfish, including one that breached 4 times, were seen off Gwennap Head SW3678215 by the Seawatch team today
- 21/7/11 An adult Harbour Porpoise was seen 300 metres west of the Gwennap Head Lookout SW365217 at 1210 hrs
- 21/7/11 “ Harbour Porpoises, and adult with a juvenile, were seen 600 metres southwest of the Gwennap Head Lookout SW365217 at 1236 hrs
- 22/7/11 32 or more Common Dolphins, in two pods, up to 17 Harbour Porpoises, 6 or 7 Ocean Sunfish, one of which breached twice, and at least 5 Grey Seals were seen off Gwennap Head SW367215 by the Seawatch team today
- 23/7/11 2 Harbour Porpoises, an adult with a juvenile, were seen heading west 500 metres southwest of Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 at 1009 hrs.
- 23/7/11 10 or more Common Dolphins, in two pods, up to 8 Harbour Porpoises, 5 Ocean Sunfish, and 9 Grey Seals were seen off Gwennap Head SW367215 by The Seawatch team today.
- 24/7/11 2 Ocean Sunfish were seen off Gwennap Head SW367215 today
- 24/7/11 A Pod of about 20 Bottlenose Dolphins was being seriously harassed by a small speed boat off The Jubilee Pool Penzance SW476297 at 1615 hrs. Watched by many people on the Prom the boat circled the pod several times then began to drive right through the pod several times. It was reported that the boat struck a dolphin on one occasion. The culprit was not identified.
- 24/7/11 3 Ocean Sunfish, one of which breached three times, and 4 Grey Seals, were seen by the Seawatch team off Gwennap Head SW367215 today.
- 25/7/11 5 Grey Seals, including one bull with a green tag on the left flipper, were seen off Gwennap Head SW367215 by the Seawatch team today
- 26/7/11 A pod of 5 Bottlenose Dolphins was seen speeding away from the Jubilee Pool area Penzance SW476297 at 1310 hrs. They were breaching and jumping as they sped seaward.
- 26/7/11 A small group, of up to 6 Common Dolphins, were spread out 500 metres to 1 Km Southeast of Porthgwarra cove Sw371216 at 1015 hrs
- 26/7/11 60 or more Common Dolphins, up to 22 Harbour Porpoises, 4 or more Grey Seals, and 2 Ocean Sunfish were seen off Gwennap Head SW367215 by the Seawatch team today
- 26/7/11 A 7 ft long Leatherback Turtle was found dead, caught in pot rope 1 mile off Bawden Rocks St Agnes SW710530
- 27/7/11 1 or 2 Minke Whales, 45 or more Common Dolphins, up to 18 Harbour Porpoises, 9 or more Grey Seals, and 2 Ocean Sunfish, one of which breached six times, were seen off Gwennap Head SW367215 by the Seawatch team today
- 27/7/11 A large pod, reported to be several hundred, Common Dolphins was seen in Mounts Penzance SW476297. They were filmed and shown on BBC TV tonight.
- 27/7/11 A Leatherback Turtle was caught alive in pot ropes off St Agnes SW746632, but was released alive.
- 28/7/11 A pod of about 10 Common Dolphins was seen just west of The Runnelstone SW369200 from 0930 to 1000 hrs
- 28/7/11 A Minke Whale was seen off Porthgwarra SW371216 today
- 28/7/11 A Minke Whale (2 sightings), 48 or more Common Dolphins, up to 35 Harbour Porpoises, 9 or more Grey Seals, and 2 Ocean Sunfish, one of which breached three times were seen off Gwennap Head SW367215 by the Seawatch team today

- 29/7/11 A Risso's Dolphin, which was tracked heading west for 40 minutes, up to 12 Harbour Porpoises, 13 or more Grey Seals, and an Ocean Sunfish which breached once were seen off Gwennap Head SW367215 by the Seawatch team today
- 29/7/11 6 Harbour Porpoises were seen feeding ½ mile south of Lamorna Cove SW451241 at 1300 hrs

- 24/12/11 5 Harbour Porpoises were spread out across Minack Bay SW387220 at 1220 hrs.
- 25/12/11 3 Harbour Porpoises were 1.5 Km SE of Porthgwarra Cove SW371216 feeding with seabirds from 1100 to 1400 hrs. These were a recognised pod of an adult with a small juvenile and another adult loosely associated with them.
